

Lake County Farm Bureau PUNKIN CHUNKIN FESTIVAL Vendor Rules



Welcome to the 2nd annual Punkin Chunkin Event. This event is where the ingenuity of humanity collides with essence of mother nature and the outcome is a Punkin Chunkin. Please include some pumpkin decorations at your booth to add to the festivities. This festival had over 400 participants attend our inaugural event in 2022. We expect more in 2023.

The Lake County Farm Bureau will make every attempt to provide an opportunity for all vendors to participate while allowing the maximum number of vendors possible. All vendors will be handled on a first come basis. Set up and take down time will be included in the fee. There will be no limitation of booth size in the festival normal operating hours. This is a fun time for everyone and the effort and fun will not be considered.

Set Up: Friday, September 30, 2023 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm OR October 1st, 2023 Prior to 9 am

Event Dates: Sunday October 1st, 2023 11 am until finished

It is required that vendors provide their own tent, tables and chairs. Vendors are responsible for collection and payment of the State Sales Tax. Required permits are the responsibility of the vendors and must be on display during operation. Food vendors must contact the Lake County health department prior to the event. Permits must be applied for, paid for, and received at least 30 days in advance of the event.

Please remember that you and your volunteers will need to wear your name tags during the event. You are responsible for your property during the event. So remember to do safety checks as they will be mailed out to you with your name tags, site map, and any last minute instructions. Remember that parking is a premium so it will be important to be inside the event minimum of one hour in advance of start time to get parking inside the venue if not you can get parking at a cost of \$10.00.

When you receive your event map, please note where the first aid station and restrooms will be located.

Remember there will be no dumping of any kind on the grounds and all your trash to the dumpster that is being provided. Leave your pets at home please.

The Lake County Farm Bureau Punkin Chunkin Committee reserves the right to have any vendor removed from the event if he or she fails to abide by any rules or regulations. A signed application constitutes a contract to follow all rules and regulations and is a commitment to participate if accepted.
